




# FEEDBACK RECEIVED – HOW TO USE THE DOCUMENT




## FEEDBACK RECEIVED – CONTENT

- ▶ General agreement and support for the structure of the document
  - ▶ Confirmation of the four priority action areas
  - ▶ No major content omissions
  - ▶ Fine-tuning of certain messages and addition of smaller aspects

## FEEDBACK RECEIVED – THE TITLE

- ***Declaration*** – perhaps difficult since it's not a political declaration in that sense, not enough high officials amongst participants
  - ***Commitment*** - on participant level fine - not on country level since there are not enough high-officials present
  - ***Consensus document*** – uncontroversial, but also the least 'punchy'
  - ***Pledge*** – uncontroversial and goes in the same direction as commitment but less official
